Hello fellow Windsor Oaks residents! I hope you've all been enjoying the cool spring weather. It looks like things will be heating up this week, so remember to drink plenty of water when you're outdoors (and make sure Fido stays hydrated, too).

Please remember that Oklahoma City is under permanent water rationing. If your address is an even number, you may use your sprinkler or sprinkler system only on even numbered days; odd days if your address is an odd number. You may use a hose to hand water on other days, but please be mindful of how much water you use. We all depend on each other to conserve this vital resource!

There continues to be a lot of positive activity going in our community. The Windsor District (The W) is Oklahoma City's only International District. The group's director, Barbie Smalley, is hard at work every week bringing area businesses and neighborhoods together. She organized our cleanup with the OU Big Event. Great job, Barbie. We had more requests than we could fill, and we're looking for more resources to hold another similar type of event before winter.

It's great to see everyone take pride in their homes and the work that you are doing to keep your yards up and your home in great shape!

The 23rd Streetscape Project is moving along, and it's so nice to drive on the new asphalt and walk on REAL sidewalks! By the end of the project, we'll have sidewalks from 1-44 to the Bethany limit on both sides of NW 23rd, with pedestrian lighting, new street and signal lights, a grand planting bed with our District's icon at the intersection of Meridian and 23rd Street and backlit markers along 23rd Street. Years of planning are becoming an exciting reality. If you're interested in receiving text message updates on the project, text STREETSCAPE to 96000. It's a totally free service to those who have a text messaging plan on your cell phone or email on computer or cell phone. It's just another benefit brought to you by the Windsor Area Business Group.

We have exciting news to report on the Safe Oklahoma Grant! Attorney General Scott Pruitt awarded a SECOND year to our area (Melrose Avenue to NW 27th Street from Council to Meridian). The OKCPD is making such great progress with crime -- and cleaning up the apartments and businesses. Please continue to report ALL SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY AND ALL CRIMES -- no matter how small it may seem. If the Police Department doesn't know when and where crime is happening, they can't move police resources there to combat it.

To keep our area in the forward progress mode, remember to shop local. When you need to shop, get a service, or enjoy a meal and some great entertainment, remember to look at The Windsor District and keep your sales tax dollars in our community. We all benefit when you do!
